The fund is supported by the Presbyterian Churches (USA) of Oconee County (Seneca, Westminster, Bethel, West Union, and Walhalla) and United Methodist Churches (Clemson and St. Mark). Since its inception, this small organization, an approved 501(c)(3) charity, has disbursed \$1,975,000 to 22,389 households. The mission has remained unchanged for 38 years. O.U.M continues to open Tuesdays and Thursdays and is staffed entirely by volunteers from the churches. All contributions go to meet the needs of families in Oconee County.
